

ESA's Weinstock Person of the Year

THE WEINSTOCK'S WOULD BE PROUD

A business leader and 40+ year security industry veteran, MacDowell was making his entry into the industry some 44 years ago and looked in the Yellow Pages under "Security." It led him to listings for industry Associations, which in turn led him to meeting with George Weinstock, Morris' son, and Les Gold, one of the industry's most highly respected and regarded legal experts and leaders. "They were extremely helpful in getting me started in the industry," MacDowell says. "So, my entry into the industry started through an Association. I felt indebted to industry work and got involved with the California Association, which was then called the Western BFAA (Burglar and Fire Alarm Association). I was born into it, and I so much admire the mentors who helped me."

Those mentors, and the trail that MacDowell himself continued to blaze on behalf of the industry, well prepared him, and qualified him, to earn the distinctive Morris F. Weinstock Award at this year's ESX. The professionalism and cohesion that Morris F. Weinstock brought to the security industry was nothing short of awesome. His life's work was dedicated to the security alarm industry. He and his brother launched Morse Signal Devices in Cleveland in the 1930s, and they later moved the business to Southern California where it grew into the largest independent installing and monitoring provider in the West. Weinstock went on to play a pivotal part in launching the National Burglar & Fire Alarm Association (NBFAA) in 1948, now known as the Electronic Security Association (ESA), and later also served as Association's president. The Morris F. Weinstock Award was initiated in 1970 and has since been regarded as one of the industry's highest honors.

Fast forward 44 years to the present day and Kirk MacDowell now has earned a plaque on his wall recognizing him as a Morris F. Weinstock Award recipient. Over the past four decades, MacDowell has worked unwaveringly for the advancement of the industry. His resume spans impressive contributions at industry innovating companies - Alarm.com, General Electric, and United Technologies - and as a Top 50 SDM integrator, and now, at his own firm, MacGuard Security Advisors, where he consults and offers guidance on how to innovate, transform, and successfully compete in today's everchanging electronic security landscape.

In addition to his work pursuits, MacDowell has devoted a ton of time to industry causes and initiatives. He remains active in many Associations serving on numerous industry and private company boards. He was the past Board of Director of the Security Industry Association (SIA) and The Monitoring Association (TMA), past Chairman of AIREF (Alarm Industry Research & Education Foundation), past President of the Los Angeles County



Burglar and Fire Alarm Association (LABFAA), past Chairman of the Security Industry Alarm Collation (SIAC), and currently serves as Chair of ESA's Leadership Identification and Nominating Committee (LINC). But anyone who has had the privilege of knowing Kirk MacDowell knows well that his contributions to the industry span far beyond the confines of his resume. He brings warmth, sincerity, and enthusiasm to not only his professional work but to his personal interactions with so many in the industry.

When asked how he has benefited personally and professionally from all his industry engagement and service, MacDowell speaks right from the heart when he replies:

"I have made terrific lifelong friends and they've become mentors and colleagues. I can call them whenever I need some help or guidance and they've been terrific. And that's benefitted me personally because I try to emulate them and do things simply for the love of the industry and its people."

That love is evident in the extensive amount of service MacDowell has generously given back to the industry. "The betterment of the industry should always be first before individual, personal gain," he says. It's not my legacy; people won't remember my name, but they'll remember the legacy that we all leave for this industry. Being able to learn from your peers - that is what our industry is all about."

Merlin Guilbeau, Chief Executive Officer of the Electronic Security Association adds that, "Kirk MacDowell's career has produced a body of work deserving of this distinguished honor. In business, he exemplifies the values of honesty and integrity, and the work ethic portrayed by Morris Weinstock. And when giving back to the industry, he leads by example with humility and gratitude, inspiring others to do the same. We are all fortunate he chose this industry to leave his mark."

"To join the ranks of the Morris F. Weinstock award, with leaders that have come before me, is humbling to say the least," MacDowell says. And as he humbly noted in his Award acceptance speech at ESX, "Getting here wasn't a solo journey. Any success I may enjoy is built on the foundational blocks laid by others before me."



This is the very mantra that our industry continues to build upon - leveraging the countless contributions made by so many dedicated industry professionals before us to propel the industry forward. "Receiving this award is not just a personal honor but a celebration of everyone who has helped shape me - my family, the dedicated MacGuard team, and all of my industry





family," MacDowell said. "This award isn't about one person; it's about all who steward Mr. Weinstock's vision."

MacDowell has been right on target in his decades-long efforts working within and for the industry. But he is wrong about one thing - people will surely always remember his name, and his legacy. And it is still going strong. Heartfelt thanks to Kirk MacDowell on behalf of the industry for his dedication and service to the security industry and congratulations on earning this well-deserved Award!




